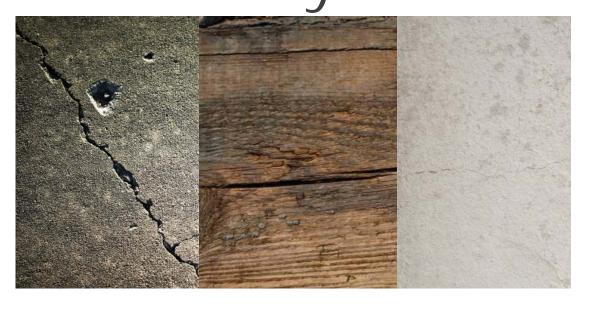


Materials with fine detail like concrete, wood, or plaster, promote a human scale. Proportion gives a sense of direction or a sense of rest.
